LEGAL ETHICS COMMITTEE

OPINION 76-47

November 9, 1977

An attorney has neither the duty nor the right to report to a grievance committee the ethics violation of another attorney, when knowledge of the violation was derived from a confidence received from a client during the course of an attorney-client relationship. The prohibition would continue to apply if the same violation was later uncovered by the attorney during discovery taken incident to litigation.

However, the attorney would have to reveal such a confidence if required by law to do so or if the information clearly established that the other attorney had perpetrated a fraud upon a tribunal.

Vice-chairman Waas stated the opinion of the committee.

After representing a client in a dissolution of marriage case, if there is no prior agreement on the part of the attorney to pursue postjudgment remedies and no petition for rehearing has been filed and the appeal period has expired, the majority of the committee feels that an attorney has no continuing obligation to represent the party in enforcing the judgment entered in the dissolution proceeding.

Once a final judgment has been entered the attorney seeking further assistance for his client should not directly communicate with the opposing party unless he has obtained consent from the attorney who represented the party in the litigation, or until he finds out that the opposing party is no longer represented by counsel.
